



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

GROUP CLASS OR INDIVIDUAL LESSONS?

Currently, we are not offering group classes. Instead, we are offering 20-min individual classes at the group class rates.

After more than 10 years of teaching group classes, we have learned that there is more learning going on in a 20-min individual class than in a 30 min group class. In a group music class setting, students are not able to learn from one another because they are instructed individually to accommodate their individual learning styles and needs. A teacher being able to focus on the needs of one student for the period of 20 minutes allows for a higher quality of learning and faster progress.

Students attending 20-min class are eligible to participate in our student recitals, Illinois Music Society Annual Exams, National Music Theory Honor Roll Exam and both competitions.

Individual lessons are great for students who are interested in learning, enjoy regular practicing at home, and want to participate in some of our more demanding programs, such as IL State Exams and Trinity College London exams. Longer lessons allow for more learning and require more practice at home. Preparation for IL State Exams in piano, violin and voice can be done only in 30 min or longer individual lessons. These lessons are also a better fit for students who would have a hard time focusing in a group setting. Students who are not ready to commit to almost daily practice would be better served in a 20-min class.
