

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

IS MY CHILD READY FOR MUSIC LESSONS?

My child always pretends to play an instrument at home, should I sign them up?

There is a difference between a child who likes to produce sounds and noise as a way of playing, and the child with the ability to focus on learning in a class and to practice deliberately at home. The parents know best if their child is ready to learn or if it is still interested in simply playing, without the clear sense of direction. Once the child is interested in learning and improving, and can follow direction, that would be a good time to consider signing them up for lessons.

We have students as young as age 4 taking lessons. They have shown interest in learning and have parental help at home, which allows them to enjoy the learning process.
