3. Tuition Payment: by credit card only. The tuition must be pre-paid for a month, around 4 lessons at a time.
4. New Students: one-time \$10 registration fee.
5. Once the tuition has been paid, we will contact you to schedule the lessons.
6. Rescheduling and Makeups. In order to receive the makeup, the student must **contact NMA or their teacher by 8 pm the day before the lesson**. This is considered a timely cancellation and the teacher will provide the makeup at a time convenient for both the student and the teacher. Cancelling the lessons by 8 pm the day before, allows the teacher to schedule somebody else in that slot and provide makeups for other students. Any cancellations after 8 pm the day before the lesson are considered late cancellations and cannot be made up. If the student does not show up for the lesson, that lesson cannot be made up.
