3. DO WE NEED TO HAVE AN INSTRUMENT AT HOME?

Yes! Music classes are more similar to math classes than sports practices and require practice at home. As a matter of fact, practice at home is essential for students to solidify what they've learned in the lessons and to continue learning in their next class. It is important to practice several days per week (preferably at least 4 days) so that the material learned in the lessons becomes a solid foundation for new learning.

When it comes to learning music, there is no substitute for deliberate, focused repetition. Talent, which is a very small component of musical success, cannot shine without consistent practice and improvement.

Guitar, ukulele, violin, and viola students need to bring their instruments to the class. Drum students need to bring their drum sticks.
